

## Hydrant Flushing

Public Works will be flushing hydrants approximately the week of April 3<sup>rd</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> from 7:30am to 4pm, depending on work load. Please watch for notices posted on the Village website [www.villageoflomira.com](http://www.villageoflomira.com), at the municipal building, post office and various businesses in the Village. Please do not wash clothes on these days, as they may be stained by rust. Drinking the water is not harmful.

Water utility customers are also reminded that the fire department conducts practices on the second Monday of each month. Since some practices require the use of water from hydrants, the water may also be rusty at these times.

## Yard Waste Clean-Up & Brush Chipping

Grass clippings and miscellaneous yard waste such as flowers, leaves and plant trimmings can be brought to the Village dump site located at 100 Pleasant Hill Avenue. The dump site is open for Village residents 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. **Grass clippings and miscellaneous yard waste should not be placed on the terrace and will not be picked up.**

Brush can be placed on the terrace. Brush (sticks and branches) which is large enough to chip (generally at least ½” in diameter, yet no more than 4” in diameter and at least three feet long) may be piled loose on the terrace and should be placed with cut ends all pointing in the same direction as the traffic travels in the lane closest to your property. Branches should not be more than 10’ long. All yokes and wyes more than 1 ½” in size must be cut through. Small brush of ½” diameter or less should be put in a solid container. **Brush placed in bags or cardboard boxes will not be picked up.** If a tree trimming service is hired for maintenance at your residence, that business is required to dispose of the tree brush. Public Works will limit brush chipping to one hour per residence per week so as to better serve the community.

Please do not place brush on the curb more than 24 hours prior to collection. Collection will be on Mondays as weather permits. Help keep the Village of Lomira attractive!

## Bulk Waste Drop-Off Date Set

The Village of Lomira will be holding a bulk waste drop-off on Saturday, May 13 from 8 a.m. to noon at the Public Works Garage, 999 N. Water Street (Next to the new water tower). This service is provided for **VILLAGE RESIDENTS ONLY** and if the following rules are not adhered to, this service may be discontinued. Bulk waste is defined as large items that do not fit in the regular garbage bags. Please note normal household refuse will not be accepted.

The following is a list of items that will be accepted and charges, if they apply:

Household furniture  
Automotive Batteries  
Scrap metal

Paint cans—provided any paint they contain is hardened.(you can dry the paint quickly by mixing it with cement)

Tires: \$3.00/car tire - - - \$15.00/larger tire

Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers and other freon containing appliances - - - \$25.00

Washers, dryers, water heaters, microwaves, stoves and other appliances that do not contain freon - - - \$20.00

Computer monitors---\$10.00

Laptops, desktop printers, fax machines, scanners, DVD players, DVRs, VCRs, video recorders, CD and cassette players, video game units, cell phones, individual computer accessories (monitor, keyboard, mouse, speakers, external hard drives, flash drives) -- \$5.00

**The Village will no longer accept TVs;** however, you can take TVs to Southwest Auto, Iron & Metal in Lomira. They will accept TVs and charge per pound. Contact Southwest for more information if needed.

## Pet Licensing Required Annually

All residents who have dogs/cats in the Village of Lomira need to have their pets licensed annually. **Licenses are valid for the calendar year (January 1 to December 31).**

Licenses must be obtained before April 1 to avoid a penalty. Owners must provide proof of rabies vaccination from their veterinarian to obtain a license. Valid proof of rabies vaccination includes the rabies manufacturer, serial number, date the vaccination was given and date the vaccination expires. Dog and cat license fees are as follows: Dogs/cats spayed/neutered \$10.00 each, un-spayed/un-neutered \$15.00 each. Licenses obtained after the due date will be assessed an additional \$5.00 late fee per pet. Failure to have your dog/cat properly licensed can result in a citation issued by the Village of Lomira PD for \$213.10 per pet per occurrence. Please see the Village Clerk to obtain your dog/cat license.

## Lomira Pool

The Lomira pool will be open June 10<sup>th</sup> to August 20<sup>th</sup>. Dodge County YMCA will manage pool operations, which include three sessions of swimming lessons, water aerobics class, special events and open swim times 7 days a week. Individual season passes cost \$45 and a family pass (up to 5 members) cost \$80. Swim lessons cost \$30 per child per session. ## Refuse/Recycling Program for Single Family, Duplex and Mobile Home Residences

Garbage and recycling services for single family homes, duplexes and mobile homes are provided by Waste Management. Any bulky item that does not fit into the carts can be disposed of by contacting Waste Management at 1-888-960-0008. Provide Waste Management with your name, address and the item(s) to be picked up. They will bill you over the phone. Bulky item pick up is scheduled for the first Wednesday of each month. Waste Management will only pick up the bulky items if you have called them to schedule the pick up.

Apartments and businesses need to contract their own garbage and recycling services and bulky item pick up.

All residents may utilize the bulk waste drop off day held in May.
